Apart from the hospital clinics, the complex boasts with many outpatient specialist labs, nephrology center, intensive care units and spinal cord treatment units. The four hospitals altogether, make the KFMC the biggest healthcare center in the Middle East.

The estimated annual operating budget of the KFMC is around 300 million saudi riyal (ca. 80 million US dollars), including medical and

SALMED 2012POZNAŃ, POLAND 14-16.03.2012


The ALVO Company presented the wide offer of brands ALVO MEDICAL, ALVO ANIMAL and Nebropath during the SALMED 2012 fair.


















ALVO MEDICAL

HOSPITAL BUILD MIDDLE EAST DUBAI, UAE 4-6.06.2012





"Glass has become a very demanded material in hospital architecture recently, especially for operating theatres. And that's due to safety and higienic qualities, as well as interesting design. Custom design art glass make the hospital environment more friendly."

Leszek Szurkowski is one of these artist, designers whose sophisticated graphics decorate the walls of operating theaters and other hospital interiors. He participates in the choice of artwork and matching colours for the interior. The possibilities are endless, the aim is one: to create a friendly environment. Customers can pick from nature themes to body-art graphics, very popular at plastic surgery clinics.

ALVO: Professor Szurkowski, what is the mistery of glass art for the Operating Room? How are the panels with graphics designed?

LES Szurkowski: Glass panels for hospitals are designed according to the interior. Psychophysiology of sight is important (distance of the observer from the graphics, scale, colors and mood of the surroundings). I visualize the interior in several graphics options, so that the Customer can try how the theme will effectuate the interior.

ALVO: Is glass a resistent enough material and does it conform to hygienic requirements which are quite arduous at the Operating Theater?

LES Szurkowski: I think glass is the best material for this kind of exposition. We use safe glass from certified suppliers only. And glass is easy to clean, non-porous surface...

ALVO: Are 'trends' also present in hospital architecture? What kind of criteria do customers use when picking graphics for the hospital?

LES Szurkowski: Trends or fashion are less important. What is vital here is the choice of motives which create atmosphere of comfort. In fact it means art that put people in good mood, a healing and soothing mood. In order to achieve it, the right colour match is important (warm colour scheme, pasteles, clear advantages, harmonious composition).

ALVO: Is there any key that you use when offering certain theme to the Customer? Will you, for example propose different

graphics to a customer in Germany and other to a customer in India or Kazakhstan?

LES Szurkowski: Usually I propose 2 options: one versatile theme and one theme attractive through local "exotics". Of course, I also respect the meaning of symbols and colours in the cultural aspect of the region.

ALVO: In well developed countries the consciousness of how environments influence the way we feel is very high. Is this awareness growing? How important, in your opinion, is the design to the staff and patients in a hospital?

LES Szurkowski: Growing interest in graphics 'inspired-by-nature' itself proofs that this awarness has growing tendency. It is obvious that human functioning in society is based on a genetically and culturally grounded reactions to the environment and surrounding world. The so called **HEALING ENVIRONMENT** is nothing else than an interior which is advantageous to our senses, where lighting, colours and nature themes harmonize. Art glass panels also optically enlarge the room and facilitate concentration.

ALVO: Prof. Andrzej Bochenek, a renown cardiosurgeon, operates in a room with big seethrough glass, enabling view over the city...

LES Szurkowski: What great idea! The atmosphere in the operating room matters to a surgeon as much as comfort on a ward does to the patient's recovery. Medical Staff spend hours in the operating room every day. So it needs to be designed carefully. But art glass is not only dedicated to operating room. We installed art glass panels in preparation rooms, over scrub sinks or on doors, and also in recovery rooms.

ALVO: Can we use any kind of high-resolution picture for art glass panels?

LES Szurkowski: Contrary to how it may seem, it is a very demanding technique. Not every picture is technically-adapted for such big dimensions. An important step when picking the picture is their technical preparation (high resolution, high-class optics used during taking the picture). Often the dimension of glass panel requires montage of few pictures together. Only after classifying technical parameters of the picture, we can focus on theme choice and it's interaction with the interior. Obviously, the distance from which the graphics will be watched matters.

ALVO: How big pictures can be used for operating theatres?

LES Szurkowski: Up to several meters. Operating rooms, where silence and concentration are important will favour graphics with simple themes that harmonize and are ideally composed.








ALVO: Is it possible to compose art glass panels with other materials eg. stainless steel, HPL?

LES Szurkowski: Of course. Glass as neutral material offers many possibilities of combination with other textures and materials. Only imagination is the limit. However I definitely prefer natural materials over artificial ones. To me, the most natural composition is stainless steel, wood, stone and water.

ALVO: Which of the ALVO projects was the most interesting challenge to you?

LES Szurkowski: India... I was wondering whether the Customers will choose theme close to their very colorful world, or will pick something totally different. They surprised me choosing plain, almost monochromatic picture. In Egypt, the Customer also expected simple landscape picture, which to them might look exotic, although to us, in this part of the world is just a view over forest or field, something very obvious.

ALVO: Thank you very much for the interview.


